## Anna Belle Wing Kindlund fonds

**Dates of creation:**

1895

**Extent:**

1 cm of textual records and graphic material (1 volume)

**Biographical sketch:**

Anna Belle Wing Kindlund (later Mrs. Alois Trnka), 1876-1922, was an artist born in Buffalo, New York. She studied with W. Hitchcock in Buffalo, and G. Bridgman in New York. She was a member of the Buffalo Society of Artists and the New York Society of Craftsmen, and is listed in *Who Was Who in American Art* as a painter and miniaturist.

**Scope and content:**

Fonds consists of a notebook commenced by Anna Belle Wing Kindlund in 1895, in which she recorded information on works of art and architectural monuments (chiefly European), with thumbnail-sized albumen prints of many of the items and occasional ink sketches. The notebook has alphabetical index tabs, and its entries are alphabetical according to city. The inscription on the frontispiece reads "Anna Belle Wing – B.S. '95". The fonds is arranged in a single series.

**Custodial history:**

The notebook was purchased, perhaps in London, England, by David Kinahan, who donated it to the Art Gallery of Ontario Library in 2004.

*Physical description:*

Notebook measures 17 x 10.5 cm.

*Physical condition:*

Notebook is in poor physical condition, with front and back covers separately detached and paper embrittled. A few photographs are detached.

*Immediate source of acquisition:*

Fonds was donated by David Kinahan in May, 2004.
