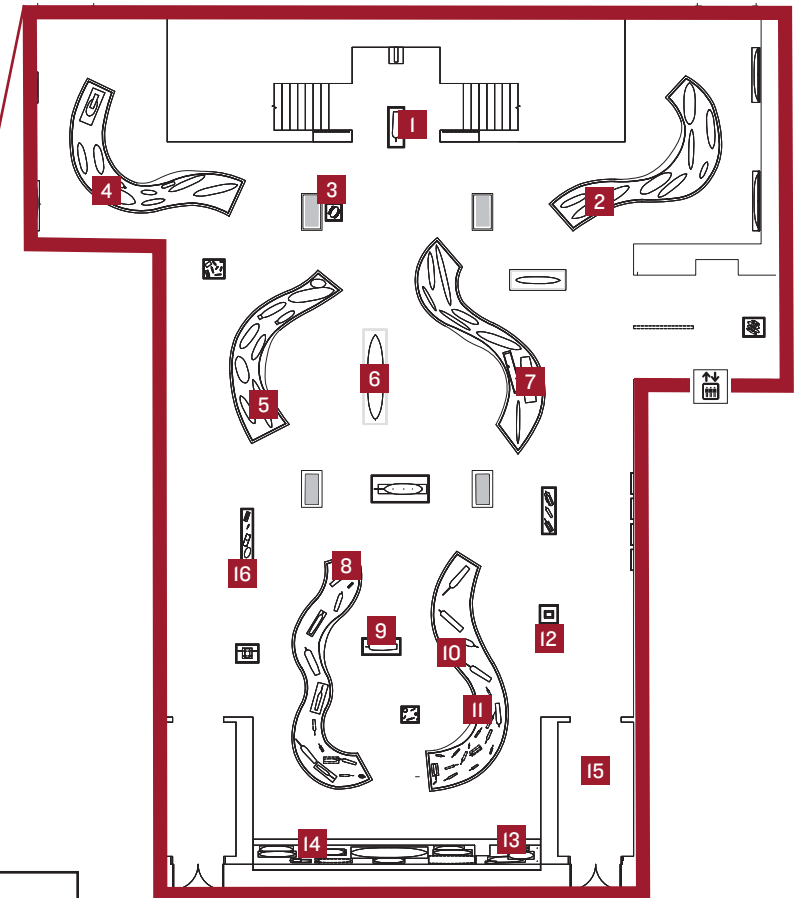

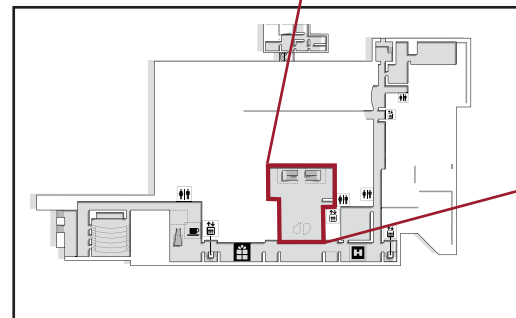

- 2 British Turret Deck Steamer, "Clan Alpine", 1899
- 3 Troop Landing Craft, around 1755-1760
- 4 Russian Icebreaker, design for two vessels: "Kosmá Mínin" and "Kniáz Pojársky", 1916
- 5 Japanese Liner, "Chichibu Maru" (renamed "Titibu Maru" in 1938, "Kamkura Maru" in 1939), around 1930
- 6 British Armoured Steam Cruiser, "H.M.S. Hogue", 1900
- 7 British Escort Aircraft Carrier, "HMS Activity", 1942
- 8 British Two-decker 50-54 Gun Warship, around 1703
- 9 British Two-decker 50 Gun Warship, "Bristol", 1774
- 10 British Revenue Lugger, "Alarm", around 1782
- 11 French Warship, "L'Ocean", 1810-1820
- 12 Double Watch Stand with British or French Two-decker 74 Gun Warship, 1795-1815
- 13 British Self-Righting Pulling and Sailing Lifeboat, around 1890,
